

## Fall incident in overgrown area

## **Incident Description**

No 467

While accessing a survey area over a field, a colleague fell into a ditch that was not noticeable due to dense vegetation. The ditch was relatively shallow and contained water. Minor bruising was sustained as well as a cut finger.

## **Recommendations**

To prevent similar incidents when carrying out inspections of ancillary items such as culverts or gullies, the use of walking poles is recommended: Colleagues should use walking poles to assist with stability and to probe the ground ahead for hidden hazards, such as ditches or uneven terrain.

Risk assessments should specifically account for potential hidden hazards in overgrown areas.
