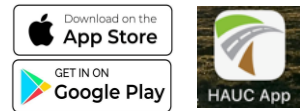


# Welcome to the HAUC App

At present it will only allow you to report instances of road worker abuse but we will look to extend this as requirements develop. If you have identified other site feedback that you believe will be valuable to provide via the HAUC App, please use the report feedback tool.

There are 6 questions to complete:

- where are you based
- which Geographical area
- where did the incident take place
- what are you reporting on?
- the abuse type?
- details on the incident

**\*\*you can then upload an image or**

video and or receive a copy of your answers. The reports come through to HAUC and we are compiling them and can provide stats on location and cause as required.

8. **ScanMyArea** – this pulls limited data from the NSG to identify potential hazards and danger within close proximity, providing valuable assistance in keeping you and your colleagues safe whilst you are on site. **\*\*NB you need to be on site for this to work\*\***

Spray and sudden flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures. There is a slight chance that power cuts could occur and other services to some homes and businesses could be lost. Where flooding or lightning strikes occur, there is a chance of delays and some cancellations to train and bus services. There is a small chance of power cuts to some homes and businesses.

System administrators can send out notifications on any number of subjects. You can receive early notification of new releases on legislation, any DFT updates or changes to existing processes as well as new guidance and consultations.
